Our Goal for this camp is to help older children develop a love for creative problem solving and hands-on projects. During this week, we plan on using materials such as clay, sand, cardboard, and even natural materials from our local woods to create creative structures. We hope to use the theory of the scientific method to even test these structures for durability, strength, and usefulness. ### During our week we will:

- Construct creative structures from clay and sand
- Build birdhouses from wood with help and demonstration from an experienced mechanical engineer
- Develop construction skills while working with craft materials such as cardboard, egg crates, or even newspaper
- Create fairy houses out of natural materials from the surrounding area
