 - Our annual costs hover around \$1 Million mostly personnel expenses.
 - Most (~75-80%) of our income is tuition and fees.
 - Remainder of income comes mostly from donations and grants.
 - We historically have strived to have 100% of tuition income go to teacher salaries/benefits. Donations/grants cover all other expenses.
